Turner Memorial Scholarship upon graduation from high school and who are attending a school that is part of the University of Alabama system (e.g., University of Alabama in Tuscaloosa, University of Alabama in Huntsville, or University of Alabama at Birmingham). Scholarships may be renewed annually. Criteria considered are: (1) need and (2) academic performance and ability. Renewal applicants must submit a college transcript, application, reference letters, and a copy of IRS 1040A or 1040EZ. Include: T, E, I from the Required Documents section below. Apply?

Q3: **Oliver Speer Harper Scholarship** - Available to students who were awarded an Olive Speer Harper Scholarship upon graduation from high school. Scholarships are renewable for four years, based on the student's college performance, financial need, and availability of funds. Amounts awarded each year will vary. College transcript and application are required for renewal applicants. Finalists may be interviewed. Include: T, E from the Required Documents section below. Apply?

Q4: **John Martin Thornton Memorial Scholarship** - Available to students who were awarded a John Martin Thornton Memorial Scholarship upon graduation from high school. Number and amounts of scholarships awarded each year will vary depending on available funds. Students who receive a scholarship their freshmen year of college may annually reapply for funding for up to 3 additional years. Availability/amounts of additional awards are contingent on student's satisfactory academic performance, financial need, and availability of funds. Renewal application and college transcript are required for renewal applicants. The committee reserves the right to conduct interviews with applicants. Include: T, E from the Required Documents section below. Apply?
